## **WHAT** is the Prescott Bird Busters:

The Prescott Bird Busters is an SCTP (Scholastic Clay Target Program) team of school aged athletes lead by volunteer SCTP certified coaches from the AZ Game and Fish Dept who teach gun safety and introduce athletes to American Trap, Skeet and Sporting Clay.

WHERE: Prescott Trap and Skeet Club, 10800 AZ-69, Dewey, AZ 86327

WHO: Youth (boys and girls) from 9yrs through full-time college students are eligible (younger athletes will need to demonstrate strength sufficient to safely control a shotgun)

Practices/Competition Times: There will typically be two practices a month from October through April (usually on Sundays). There will be <a href="mailto:three-competitions">three competitions</a> each season requiring travel to Phoenix and/or Tucson. There may be optional out of state (i.e. Las Vegas) competitions. Each athlete is responsible for their own travel. <a href="mailto:This is a team sport and regular attendance is expected.">This is a team sport and regular attendance is expected.</a> If absent, advance communication with your coach is required. The season calendar of specific dates and times will be provided once available.

Qualifications: School GPA, Dedication to safety, Strength to control firearm, Desire to learn, Positive attitude, and a willingness to listen

**Team Fees (no refunds):** \$200.00 Cash or Check (Prescott Bird Busters) + **\$20 Booster Club**Membership and volunteer time in the PBB Boosters Club (i.e. team activities, fundraising)

\* Note that team fees are significantly discounted thanks to the PBB Boosters Club fundraising. PBB pays for clay targets and ammo for each practice and for ammo at competitions. Athletes are responsible for their own competition target registration fees. Targets and ammo costs exceed \$600 per athlete each season.

**Guns:** You do not need to have your own gun. PBB has club guns that will be available for athlete use. If using your own gun, it must be either 12ga or 20ga and will need to be inspected and approved by a PBB Coach.

Maximum # of Athletes: Our shooting facilities and coaching staff can support up to 40 athletes. Athletes accepted will be on a 'first come, first serve' basis with priority going to returning athletes.

**Forms:** You will be required to sign athlete registration forms from SCTP, AZGFD and PBB including athlete consent, athlete code of conduct, sportsmanship contract, medical consent, and COVID-19 liability waiver.
